ADELAIDE-based healthcare software company PowerHealth Solutions has won a major contract to supply its technology across 200 hospitals in Canada.

The Quebec Government has selected the South Tce firm as the preferred provider of a patient level-costing system which, pending final testing, will be rolled out across the province's network of 200 hospitals.

The company says the project aims to deliver robust patient level-costing across all acute, subacute, mental health and primary care patients over a three-year period.

PowerHealth Solutions, managing director Patrick Power said the company was "privileged" to have been selected for the project.

The project was awarded following an extensive bidding process as part of the reform to establish patient-centred funding within the Quebec health and social services network.
