

Saab build to create jobs

A WIN for Saab Australia will create 50 new South Australian jobs.

Saab will provide the Situational Awareness System for the 12 new Offshore Patrol Vessels. Defence Industry Minister Christopher Pyne will announce the contract today.

Lurssen Australia is leading the \$3.6 billion OPV project.

“The System provides the navy with complete, consistent and up-to-date situational awareness and mission management,” Mr Pyne said.

The first two OPVs will be built in SA before moving to Western Australia.
