Bowhill Engineering shortlisted for 2019 Telstra business award

Murraylands firm Bowhill Engineering has been named one of 24 finalists in the 2019 Telstra Business Awards.

The company was one of six named in the medium and making waves category.

It was last recognised at the awards in 2014, when it took out a category for regional businesses.

Managing director Jeremy Hawkes said his company was passionate about collaborating with its customers, not just taking their orders, on large and complex steel fabrication projects.

Telstra consumer and small business executive Michael Ackland said being named a finalist was an achievement in itself, given 21,000 nominations had been received nationally.

"Three quarters of last year's state finalists saw a spike in activity or business awareness just from taking part in the program," he said.

Finalists were assessed on their strategy and vision, customers and marketing, operations, people and culture, innovation and technology, social responsibility and financial acumen.

The state winners will be announced on September 12 ahead of a national awards night on November 21.
