

Local lands a key role

SOUTH Australian Daniel Le Feuvre has been appointed to the AgriFutures Australia board, responsible for planning, investing and managing research and development in agriculture.

Mr Le Feuvre, managing director of Australian Bee Services, is among six people appointed for a three-year term by Federal Agricultural Minister David Littleproud.

"The Australian Government invests around \$1.1bn a year in innovation and research and development for the agricultural sector," Mr Littleproud said.

"The new directors will ... assist Australia's agricultural industries to seize opportunities in our agricultural innovation system as the sector faces unprecedented change and emerging risks."
