

Power win for Lincoln

A \$234m transmission line will be built on the Eyre Peninsula, after receiving approval from the Australian Energy Regulator yesterday.

ElectraNet will replace an ageing asset and build a 270km high-voltage transmission line from Cultana to Port Lincoln by December 2022.

It will improve both the reliability and security of supply to homes and businesses on the Eyre Peninsula.

Replacing the transmission line will also save the backup generation costs currently paid by consumers to secure supply to the area.
