South Australian wineries named amongst best in the world

Three South Australian wineries were named in the 2023 World's Best Vineyards Top 50 list.

In 17th place on the list, d'Arenberg in McLaren Vale was accolated as Australia's best vineyard.

Henschke in Eden Valley ranked next as the 26th-best vineyard in the world, while Penfold's Magill Estate rounded out the trio in 44th place.

South Australia was the only Australian state with vineyards ranking amongst the list's Top 50.

According to the list, the world's best vineyard is Catena Zapata in Mendoza, Argentina.

Argentina bolstered the list, with Bodegas Salentein and El Enemigo Wines also featured in the top ten.
